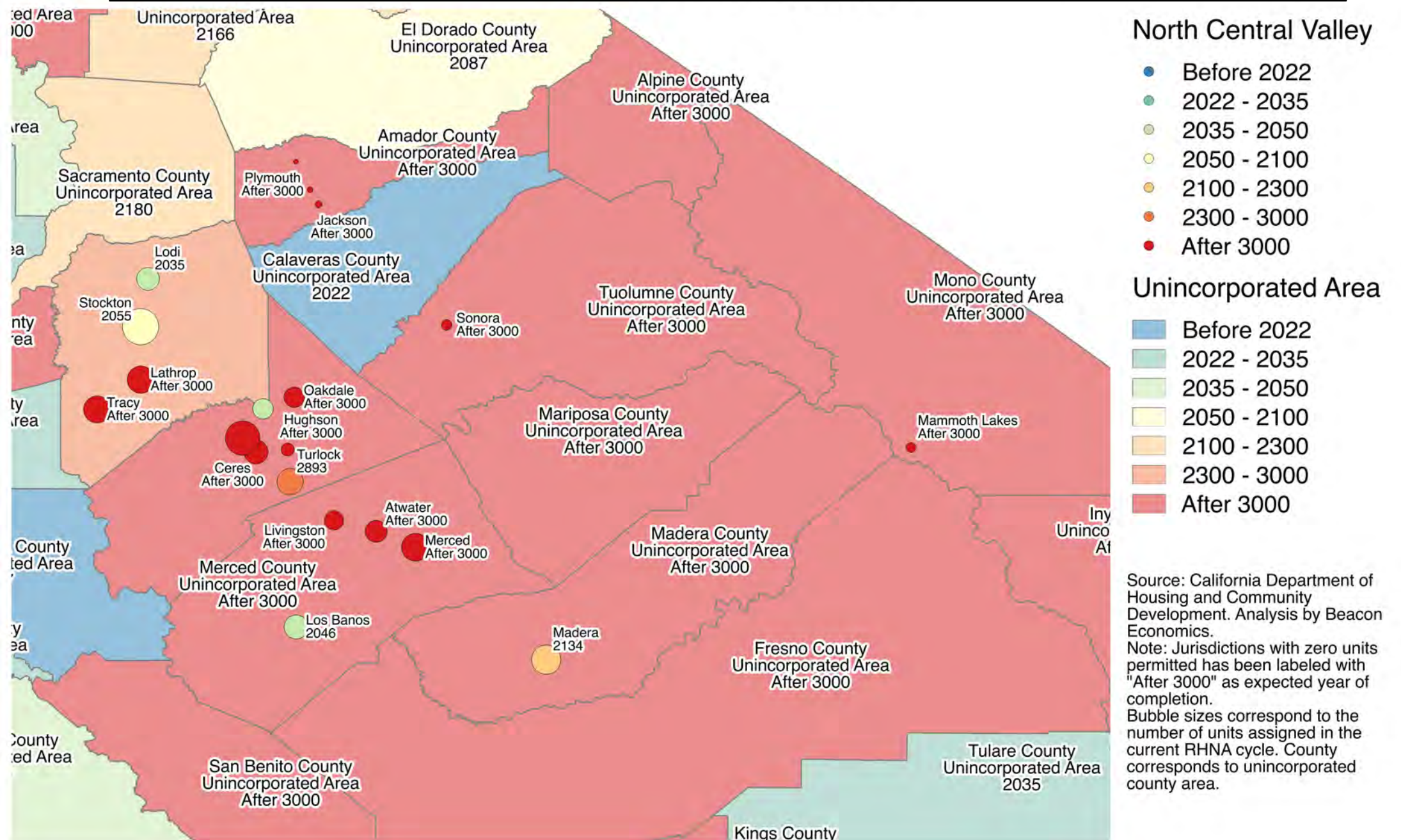


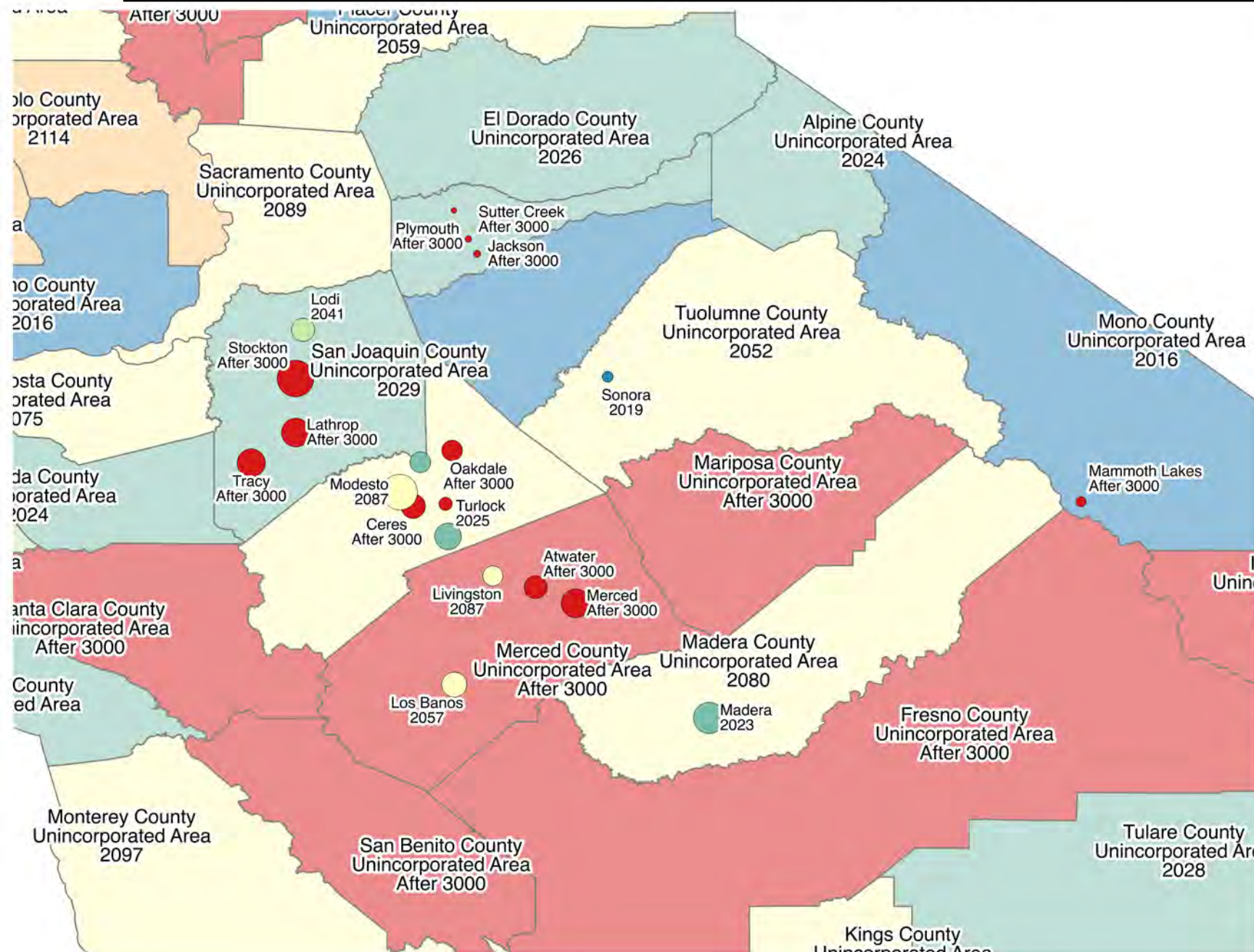
Very Low Income RHNA Allocation and Progress North Central Valley Region

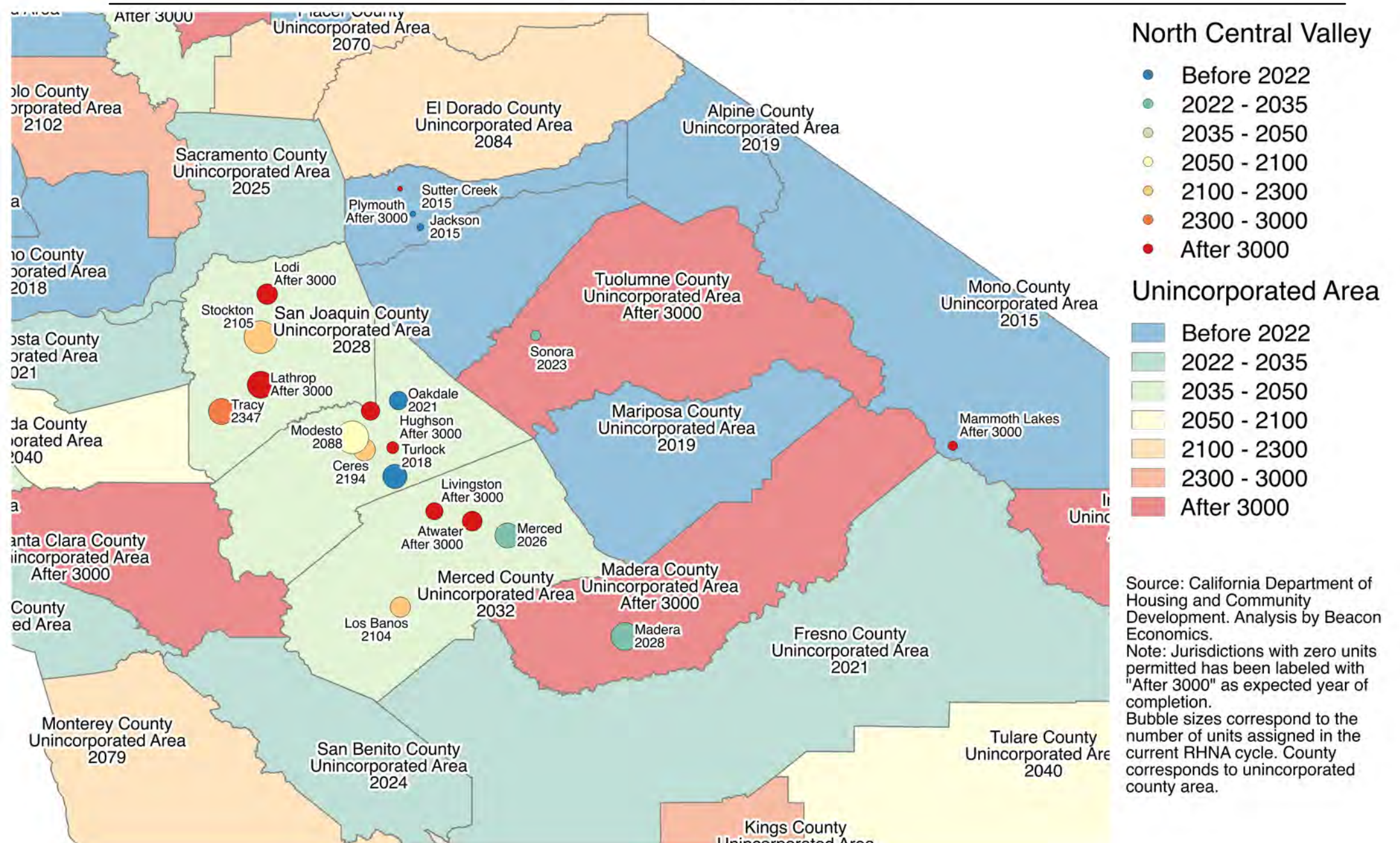

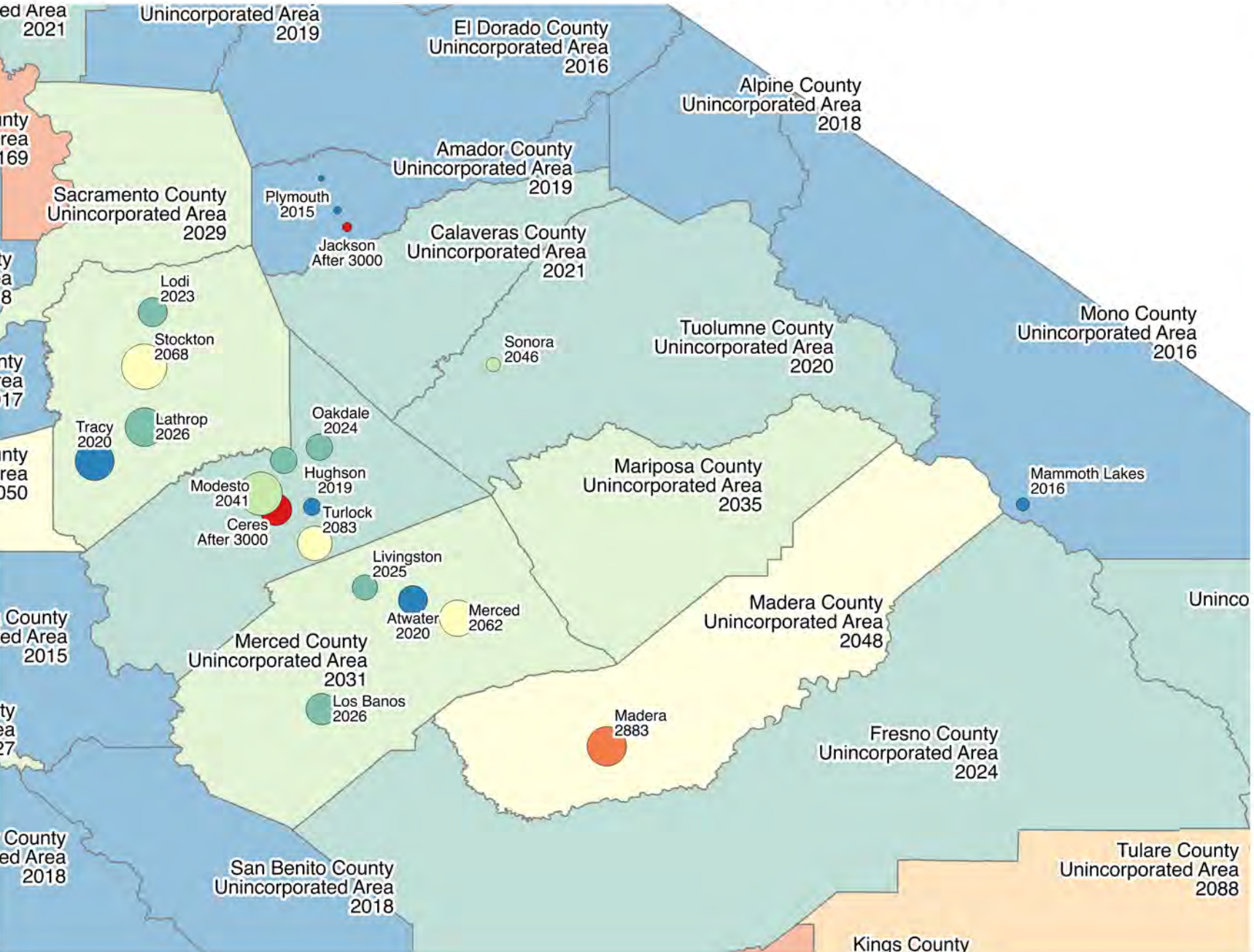
