



## Highlights:

The Latino population is overwhelmingly young: 42% of the Latino population is under 19 and 73% is under 40 (See Figure 1).


48% of the White population is 40 and older (See Figure 1).


Overall, 60,000 jobs were lost in 2010, which experienced job increases in 13 years out of the 15 years between 1996 and 2010 (See Figure 6).
























HIGHLIGHTS Latinos are the majority in the region, representing 49% of the population (See Figure 1).

The unemployment rate in the region is consistently higher than California's unemployment rate. In 2010 the region had a 17% unemployment rate, while the California unemployment rate was 12% (See Figure 5).

In 2010, nearly 140,000 jobs were lost due to firms closing down (See Figure 6).
